The average price of electricity in Netherlands, in December of 2023, has been 0.475€ per kilowatt hour. Electricity price has not changed since the last semester. Meanwhile, the average price of electricity without taxes in Netherlands in that period was € 0.4436 per kilowatt hour,, as in the previous period.

What is the price cap for electricity in the Netherlands?

Price Cap: Due to soaring energy prices, the Dutch government has set a price cap on electricity (€0.40 per kWh) and gas (£1.45 per m3). Limits: For 2023, the limits are 2,900 kWh for electricity and 1,200 m3 for gas. Monthly consumption is gauged by examining usage before and after the annual bill.

What happens if you pay more for energy contracts in the Netherlands?

As a result, from 1 January onwards, all consumers again pay the prices in their energy contracts. In December 2023, approximately 450,000 households in the Netherlands had a contract with prices above the price cap. For consumers who now pay more, it can pay off to look for more economical contracts and to switch energy suppliers.

What are the different types of energy contracts in the Netherlands?

Energy contracts in The Netherlands distinguish between three different types of energy prices: fixed, variable, and dynamic energy prices. With a fixed energy contract, the prices for electricity and/or gas remain fixed for a set period. This period can be for six months, one year, three years, or five years.

The Netherlands primarily relies on natural gas, wind energy, and biomass for its electricity generation. Natural gas stands out as the predominant source, contributing significantly to the country's energy mix.


