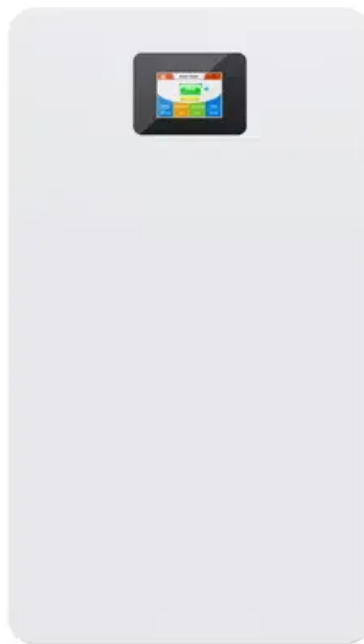

When tea is stored in transparent containers, light can also generate unwanted heat, further accelerating the damage. Heat effects are equally detrimental to tea's integrity. Temperatures above 25°C (77°F) speed up

oxidation and break down essential oils, leading to stale flavors and loss of aromatic qualities.

How should tea be stored?

All teas benefit from being stored in a cool dry place where the temperature does not fluctuate very much. Tea is very good at absorbing odours so keep it away from anything smelly. 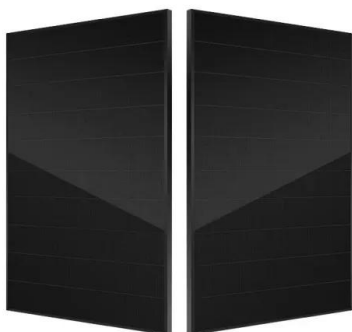
How long does tea last in airtight containers?

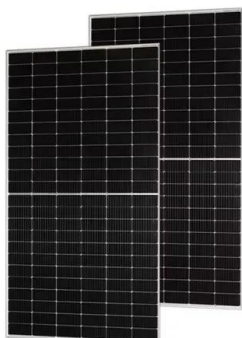

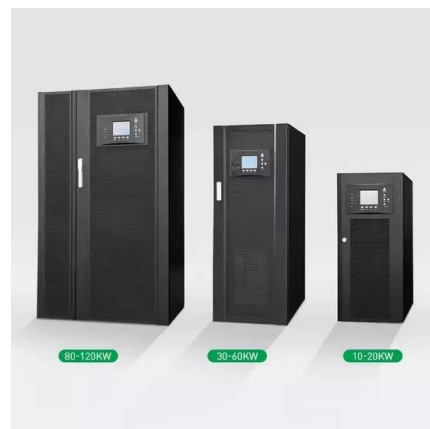

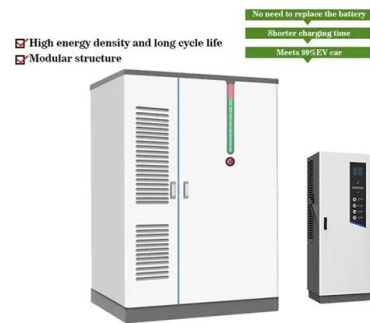
